POSITION OVERVIEW:

SKILLS REQUIRED:

- Expertise installing sealants, including two-parts, hybrids, self-leveling, silicones, and polyurethanes.
- Thorough knowledge of ASTM and BIA industry standards, building codes, and OSHA safety regulations.
- Comfort working from scaffold, swings, and lifts, as well as in trenches and tight spaces.
- Ability to read blueprints, specifications, and product safety data sheets.
- Ability to safely lift 75-100 pounds.

JOBSITE DUTIES MAY INCLUDE:

- Installation of backer-rod and sealants between tilt-up concrete panels or poured concrete pads.
- Setting architectural cast stone, flagstone, bluestone, slate, limestone, and granite panels.
- Cutting out, cleaning, and/or prepping movement joints in unit masonry on renovation/restoration projects.
- Installation of total wall systems, including anchors, insulation, air & vapor barriers, sealants, and flashing.
