### ABOUT THE COMPANY:

### POSITION OVERVIEW:

General Laborers/Mason Tenders with Eshbach Brothers, L.P. typically work on crews ranging from one to ten mason tenders to support bricklayers and the foremen. Our jobsites are located throughout eastern Pennsylvania and travel is required. Foremen supervise projects under the guidance of our Field Superintendent and Project Managers, based in the Office. Members of field leadership, all holding OSHA-30 credentials, are committed to your safety and you are expected to participate in weekly toolbox talks. As a General-Laborer/Mason-Tender on the Eshbach Brothers, L.P. team, you are provided the equipment necessary to excel at your trade with opportunities for continued education and professional certifications.

### SKILLS REQUIRED:

- Technical expertise in mixing mortar and grout, operating concrete mixers, grout hogs, and towers.
- Ability to operate forklifts and off-road forklifts; knowledge of forklift and crane hand signals.
- Comfort building scaffold; working from scaffold and lifts, as well as working in trenches and tight spaces.
- Knowledge of industry standards, building codes, and OSHA safety regulations.
- Ability to stock materials in an efficient timeframe so bricklayers have materials when needed.
- Ability to safely lift 75-100 pounds.

### JOBSITE DUTIES MAY INCLUDE:

- Mixing mortar for bricklayers and mixing grout for wall reinforcement.
- Stocking scaffold with mortar, brick, and concrete block, and wall system accessories for bricklayers.
- Site mobilization and building scaffolding and fraco systems as jobs progress from one elevation to the next.
- Operation of off-road forklifts, forklifts, aerial lifts, and scissor lifts.
